The achievement and accomplishment can be in the areas of industry, research, teaching, business, public service, technology development, technology innovation, or advancing the profession of Biological Engineering. 	<p>Other Details</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Electronic submissions are encouraged. • Nominate yourself or a colleague. • New awardees will be presented at the 2010 IBE Annual Meeting. • Nominees not designated an IBE Fellow will be maintained and reviewed for 3 consecutive years.
